13:30 - Arrives Copacabana - Charming fishing town on the other side of Lake Titicaca

14:00 - 18:00 - EXTRA Isla del Sol Boat Tour (4 hrs) - Visit the birthplace of the Inca legend (can also be done on the return journey from La Paz if preferred)

To do a Colca Canyon Trek requires a minimum of 3-4 days in Arequipa (1 day altitude acclimatisation needed) and will depend on the option you want to do (2 Day/1 Night Trek or 3 Days/2 Nights).

20:30 - Arrives Paracas - Beautiful small town by the sea

16:00 - 17:00 - Bus to Hacienda San Jose/Secret Slave Tunnels

17:00 - 18:00 - FREE Secret Slave Tunnels Tour – Take a tour through the secret underground tunnels that were used to smuggle slaves in the XVII century, spanning over 17km and only recently discovered!

18:00 - 22:30 - Arrives Lima - Hotel/hostel drop-off
