NOTE: Starting a 2 Day Tour after an overnight bus can be very tiring...the 1 day option might be best for you. To do a Colca Canyon Trek requires a minimum of 3-4 days in Arequipa (1 day altitude acclimatisation needed) and will depend on the option you want to do (2 Day/1 Night Trek or 3 Days/2 Nights).
